Dear Students!

We would like to inform you that the Student Opinion on Teaching (OMHV) process for the spring semester of 2024/2025 has been launched.

Data collection for the Faculty of Law and the teachers of the Language Teaching Centre are primarily done in the Neptun Unipoll system. The majority of the surveys will continue to be sent out through the Evasys system, expected on 28th July. Surveys will be run until a minimum response rate of 20% is achieved, with some surveys closing no later than 31st August.

The range of lecturers and subjects or courses to be included in the evaluation has been defined by the Faculties in their sampling plans.

They will be informed of their participation in the surveys by sending an e-mail to the e-mail address provided on Neptun. Anonymity is fully guaranteed during data collection and evaluation. The Evasys system will automatically send a participation reminder every 7 days for surveys that have not yet been answered. (The system will only and exclusively retrieve information on whether or not a response has been received from a given e-mail address for a given survey. Responses received cannot be matched to e-mail addresses. This has been taken priority of by the system developers to ensure anonymity.)

The aim of the OMHV questionnaire is to contribute to the improvement of the quality of education at the University of Miskolc by getting students' opinions. According to Article 19. § (2) e) of the Student Requirement System, students are obliged to give their opinion on the work of the teaching staff, therefore we kindly ask you to take the time to fill in the questionnaire and give us your opinion. (Please express your opinion in accordance with 17. §. article 4 of the Code of Ethics, which states that your opinion should be "appropriate in tone, concrete, based on real perception, personal experience, objective, considered, unbiased.") The maximum time required to complete a questionnaire is 3-5 minutes. It will help teachers to get important feedback on the subjects taught and the teaching methods. The student feedback is also an important part of the individual performance evaluation system for teachers and of the university's teaching application process.

The aggregated results of the surveys will be available on the Quality Assurance section of the University website.
